This Order is made under section 59(1)(a) of the *Water Management Act 2000*. The object of this Order is to make an available water determination for various categories of access licences in the water sources identified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

## **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Available Water Determination Order for the NSW Murray Regulated River Water Source 2020-21 [No.3]*.

## **2 Commencement**

This Order commences on the 17<sup>th</sup> of August 2020

## **3 Available water determination**

This Order determines the availability of water in relation to the water sources specified in Schedule 1, for the categories and subcategories of access licence specified in Schedule 2, on the terms specified in Schedule 2.

## Schedule 1 Water Sources

This Order applies to the NSW Murray Regulated River Water Source (as identified in Clause 4 of the *Water Sharing Plan for the NSW Murray and Lower Darling Regulated Rivers Water Sources 2016*).

## Schedule 2 Access licences and terms

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to the adjacent category/subcategory of access licence specified in Column 1.

<b>COLUMN 1</b> <b>Category/ subcategory of access licence</b>	<b>COLUMN 2</b> <b>Volume per unit of access licence share component</b>
Regulated river (Conveyance) access licences	0.0195 megalitre
Regulated river (general security) access licences	0.05 megalitre

Notes: (1) An available water determination made in relation to a particular category of access licence applies to all subcategories of that category, except to the extent to which this order provides otherwise, in accordance with section 59 (1A) of the *Water Management Act 2000*.
