#### Access Rules

<b>Castlereagh River Binnaway to Gilgandra management zone</b>	
Cease to pump	Pumping is only permitted when a flow is visible. Note: This rule applies to all extraction from rivers and creeks including natural in-river pools within the channels of rivers and creeks.
Reference point	At water supply work (pump, diversion pipe, etc.).
Daily pumping restrictions	While there is no visible flow, pumping is not permitted for any 24-hour period starting at 18:00 on an even-numbered calendar day under an access licence that nominates a water supply work (spearpoint) within the alluvial sand beds.
Amendment provision	If a camera trial to establish when flow is above the sand beds is successful, then the plan may be amended in year four in order to allow the camera to be used to define visible flow.
<b>Binnaway to Gilgandra Tributaries management zone – access rules for rivers and creeks</b>	
Cease to pump	Pumping is only permitted when a flow is visible. Note: This rule applies to all extraction from rivers and creeks including natural in-river pools within the channels of rivers and creeks.
Reference point	At water supply work (pump, diversion pipe, etc.).
<b>Binnaway to Gilgandra Tributaries management zone – access rules for natural off-river pools</b>	

Cease to pump	<p>Pumping is not permitted when the water level in that natural off-river pool is lower than its full capacity</p> <p><b>Note:</b> 'Full capacity' can be approximated by the pool water level at the point where there is no visible flow into and out of that pool.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Natural off-river pools include those pools located on flood runners, floodplains and effluents e.g. lakes, lagoons and billabongs.</p>
Reference point	Individual natural off-river pool

<b>Castlereagh River-Timor Dam to Pound Yard Weir Management Zone</b>	
Cease to pump	Pumping is only permitted when a flow is visible. Note: This rule applies to all extraction from rivers and creeks including natural in-river pools within the channels of rivers and creeks.
Reference point	At water supply work (pump, diversion pipe, etc.).
<b>Castlereagh River-Pound Yard Weir to Merryula Road Crossing Management Zone</b>	
Cease to pump	Pumping is only permitted when a flow is visible. Note: This rule applies to all extraction from rivers and creeks including natural in-river pools within the channels of rivers and creeks.

<b>Belar Creek Management Zone</b>

<b>Independent Tributaries Management Zone</b>

<b>Flow Classes</b>	
Flow classes have been established for all management zones except the Independent Tributaries management zone. However they do not take effect until appropriate infrastructure can be used as a flow reference point. Notification of flow class commencement will be provided in writing by the Department to all affected licence holders.
